We entered our first year of operation with three main objectives: 1) fill this place, 2) develop and enhance the retreat experience, and 3) improve and beautify the facilities. Each goal was met beyond our wildest imagination.

This was an amazing year highlighted by the success of the Family Enrichment Retreat weekends. Barren Heights hosted 9 retreats for more than 20 guest and co-host families. Volunteers and guests were touched in so many ways. As the season progressed, the retreat content improved as volunteers and guests left their imprint on the program.

Additionally, over 40 volunteers came to the camp in early April and planted trees, built a barn theatre, upgraded a bunkhouse, and improved the pathways.

And the last highlight of the year was the benefit dinner held the first Tuesday of November. The benefit was a success as it served to spread the word about Barren Heights and raise nearly \$25,000 that will be used to serve families in 2007.
